The judging of the 2021 Youth film competition sponsored by the Lambton Film and Food Festival is complete and the results are in. This year was particularly challenging, with all films and judging being done via Zoom and Google Meet.

A total of nineteen films were submitted from four high schools within Lambton and Kent Counties after nearly ninety students participated in the film workshops. The films were produced by students between grades nine and twelve.

The quality of the films was exceptional, especially considering the students had limited to no access to specialty equipment from the schools. Each year we are impressed with the quality of films produced.

Films were submitted in a number of categories including: Comedy, Drama, Documentary, Animation, Other, and the newly created categories Music Video and Music/Animation.
